John Cowper Powys (/ ʔ k u ʔ p ʔ r ʔ p o ʔ ʔ s /; 8 October 1872 – 17 June 1963) was a British philosopher, lecturer, novelist, literary critic, and poet. Another extraordinary (and impossible to review, really) book from John Cowper Powys: The only things to which I can compare it are Proust, from whose depths Powys has clearly imbibed, and *The Glastonbury Romance*, except that this work seems much the much deeper and sadder of the two Powys works, touching on the subjects most dear to Powys ... Powys was has a poet's touch like John Donne.
