

Download Acoustic Immittance Measures

Tympanometry is one of several tests that audiologists call "immittance" tests. A tympanometer measures the acoustic immittance in the external auditory meatus as a function of air pressure within the external auditory meatus. Example 2 : No output on one side (7th nerve) prior to inner ear on L - -everything measured on left side is gone. See comments above in anatomy section concerning location of lesions in 7th nerve.
