Foreword. In 1998, the AGROPOLIS programme was launched by the International Development Research Centre (IDRC) to encourage young scholars to undertake research on urban agriculture (UA). Although public awareness for farming activities in cities is slowly increasing, agriculture is still in many cases not yet included in the urban planning. This volume, by researchers working in urban agriculture, examines concrete strategies to integrate city farming into the urban landscape. Drawing on original field work in cities across the rapidly urbanizing global South, the book examines the contribution of urban agriculture and city farming to livelihoods and food security.
