INEQUALITY AND INCOME: Income inequality in OECD countries is at its highest level for the past half century. The average income of the richest 10% of the population is about nine times that of the poorest 10% across the OECD, up from seven times 25 years ago. The gap between America's upper-income and middle-income families has reached its highest level on record. In 2013, the median wealth of the nation's upper-income families (\$639,400) was nearly seven times the median wealth of middle-income families (\$96,500). America's wealth gap is getting even bigger. While wages for low- and middle-income workers have begun to recover, wealth inequality has still climbed to new heights, according to a new survey ...
