Here at our St. Louis nursery and garden center the discerning gardener finds exceptional plants, unmatched service, and the largest selection of perennials anywhere. An in-depth list with descriptions of Arkansas wildflowers was written by Carl G. Hunter and published by the Ozark Society Foundation in 1984. Hunter covered 600 species of native wildflowers and included 484 photographs. People choose to substitute native grass lawns for conventional turfgrass when they want part of their garden to have a carpeted look or be used for walking or running activities, but they don't want to embrace the regimen of chores that conventional lawns require. Ajuga (Bugleweed) Ajuga is an evergreen groundcover that can grow in the shade of large trees where grass is hard to establish. Unlike many perennials that are grown only for their flowers, ajuga is prized for its attractive, colorful foliage that looks nice all year.
