The aim of this paper is to identify a cluster of symptoms and behaviours, which I am proposing be classified as 'Boarding School Syndrome'. These patterns are observable in many of the adult patients, with a history of early boarding, who come to psychotherapy. Boarding School Syndrome is an analysis of the trauma of the 'privileged' child sent to boarding school at a young age.
