"BRITISH WARSHIPS, 1914-1919", published by Ian Allan, 1972, is the only available listing of most of the vessels that served in the Royal Navy during the Great War and into 1919. Status: Imperial political structure (comprising British India, a quasi-federation of presidencies and provinces directly governed by the British Crown through the Viceroy of India, princely states, governed by Indian rulers, under the suzerainty of the British Crown exercised through the Viceroy of India) Capital The Brandenburg-class ships were the first ocean-going battleships built for the German navy, and marked the beginning of German naval expansion. Meares had left Canton [Guangzhou] with two British-built ships, the Felice and the Iphigenia. He wrote: "The crews of these ships consisted of Europeans and China-men, with a larger proportion of the former."
