INTRODUCTION — Reversible cerebral vasoconstriction syndromes (RCVS) are a group of conditions that show reversible multifocal narrowing of the cerebral arteries with clinical manifestations that typically include thunderclap headache and less commonly focal neurologic deficits related to brain edema, stroke, or seizure.
