As part of the Cardwell and Childers Reforms of the British Army's regiments, in 1881 the 68th (Durham) Regiment of Foot (Light Infantry) and the 106th Regiment of Foot (Bombay Light Infantry) became the 1st and 2nd battalions of the Durham Light Infantry. Despite the heavy losses sustained during the war, the Sherwood Foresters won many battle honours for outstanding acts of bravery, including a number of Victoria Crosses and over 2000 other decorations, honours and distinctions.
