Codex Sinaiticus - Translated from the oldest complete New Testament text, the Sinaiticus. Includes twenty-nine (29) books. Codex Sinaiticus is one of the most important books in the world.

Handwritten well over 1600 years ago, the manuscript contains the Christian Bible in Greek, including the oldest complete copy of the New Testament. Codex Sinaiticus was discovered by Constantin Tischendorf in a convent at the foot of Mount Sinai. It contains the entire Greek Bible, plus the Epistle of Barnabas and most of the Shepherd of Hermas (early Christian writings which were widely used in teaching). B or 03) is one of the oldest extant vellum manuscripts of the Bible, written in uncial letters.
