Leader Resource 1, Conflict Resolution Scenarios; Timepiece (minutes) Optional: Simple props; Preparation for Activity. Print out Leader Resource 1 and cut the two scenarios apart ; Description of Activity. Participants create a skit to portray a conflict and then re-create the skit to show different possible solutions. Form two groups. Give each group a scenario from Leader Resource 1.
