Ezra F. Vogel is the author of numerous books on Japan and China, including *Deng Xiaoping and the Transformation of China*, a finalist for the National Book Critics Circle Award for Biography and winner of the Lionel Gelber Prize and named Best Book by *The Economist*, *Washington Post*, and *Financial Times*. One volume (*My Father, Deng Xiaoping*) is about Deng's life before 1949, and the other (*Deng Xiaoping and the Cultural Revolution*) describes the time when Deng Rong accompanied her parents in exile away from Beijing in Jiangxi province from 1969 to 1973.
