The Church History (Greek: ἱστορία ἐκκλησιαστικὴ ἢ ἐκκλησιαστικὴ ἱστορία; Latin: *Historia Ecclesiastica* or *Historia Ecclesiae*) of Eusebius, the bishop of Caesarea was a 4th-century pioneer work giving a chronological account of the development of Early Christianity from the 1st century to the 4th century. Eusebius' *Ecclesiastical History* is one of the classics of early Christianity and of equal stature with the works of Flavius Josephus. Eusebius chronicles the events of the first three centuries of the Christian church in such a way as to record a vast number of vital facts about early Christianity that can be learned from no other ancient source.
