

Download Failure Of A Revolution Germany 1918 1919

First stage: 29 October – 9 November 1918 (1 week and 4 days) Second stage: 3 November 1918 – 11 August 1919 (9 months and 1 week) Similar to what Marx predicted, there was an actual socialist revolution in Germany. It happened at the end of World War One. But it was defeated, because there was no vanguard revolutionary communist party, and leaders, in place. Name. The Weimar Republic is so called because the assembly that adopted its constitution met at Weimar, Germany from 6 February 1919 to 11 August 1919, but this name only became mainstream after 1933. The end of the fighting on the Western Front in November 1917 came as something of a surprise to both sides. Germany's plight was, of course, desperate.
