In 1790, a thousand tons of cotton were being produced every year in the South. The ancient Greeks had several words to indicate slaves, which leads to textual ambiguity when they are studied out of their proper context. In Homer, Hesiod and Theognis of Megara, the slave was called δμῶν (dmōn). The term has a general meaning but refers particularly to war prisoners taken as booty (in other words, property).
