The Germanic peoples are those who spoke one of the Germanic languages, and they thus originated as a group with the so-called first sound shift (Grimm's law), which turned a Proto-Indo-European dialect into a new Proto-Germanic ...
Germany - The migration period: The situation was transformed by nomadic, non-Germanic Hunnish horsemen from the east who pushed Germanic peoples into the Roman Empire in several waves. First, in 376, Visigoths were admitted by the emperor Valens as foederati ("allies") to farm and defend the frontier. This procedure was not without ...
