It is one of the fastest growing plants and was one of the first plants to be spun into usable fiber 10,000 years ago. It ...Hemp is a distinct variety of the plant species *Cannabis sativa* L. that grows to a height anywhere from 4-15 ft (1.2-4.5 m) and up to 0.75 in (2 cm) in diameter. Industrial hemp can make our future roads, highways and freeways from hemp based concrete, which lasts for centuries. Society can benefit from the hemp plant's attributes such as oxygen production, hemp's dense root structure, and hemp's nutrient and nitrogen production back into the soil.
