Bhopal (/ b o ? ? p ?? l /; Hindustani pronunciation: [bʰoʔpaʔl] ) is the capital city of the Indian state of Madhya Pradesh and the administrative headquarters of Bhopal district and Bhopal division. Geography. December 1. December 1, 1640 - A nationalist revolution in Portugal led to independence from Spain as the Spanish garrisons were driven out of Portugal.
