He taught at Hampshire College, Mount Holyoke College, and Trinity College before joining the faculty at Reed College in 1978. David Jeffrey Griffiths (born 1942) is a U.S. physicist and educator. He worked at Reed College from 1978 through 2009, becoming the Howard Vollum Professor of Science before his retirement.
