Julia first appears in Nineteen Eighty-Four at the age of 26, an enthusiastic participant in the Two Minutes Hate directed against Emmanuel Goldstein, a Party co-founder who claims the Revolution was betrayed. At one point, she flings a Newspeak dictionary at the telescreen. Nineteen Eighty-Four, often published as 1984, is a dystopian novel by English writer George Orwell published in June 1949. The novel is set in the year 1984 when most of the world population have become victims of perpetual war, omnipresent government surveillance and propaganda. Julia is the name of a fictional character from George Orwell's dystopian novel Nineteen Eighty-Four. Her last name is never given in the novel. According to herself, Julia was born in 1958 in Oceania, the superstate combining North America, South America, Southern Africa, Australia, New Zealand and the United Kingdom (renamed Airstrip One). 1984 (Originaltitel: Nineteen Eighty-Four, deutscher Alternativtitel: Neunzehnhundertvierundachtzig), geschrieben von 1946 bis 1948 und erschienen im Juni 1949, ist ein dystopischer Roman von George Orwell (eigentlich Eric Arthur Blair), in dem ein totalitärer Überwachungsstaat im Jahre 1984 dargestellt wird.
