

# Download Kentucky River Mills V Jackson

Lage und Abgrenzung. Kentucky liegt zwischen 36°30' und 39°9' nördlicher Breite und zwischen 81°58' und 89°34' westlicher Länge. Das Staatsgebiet erstreckt sich damit über 225 km in nordsüdlicher und 610 km in ostwestlicher Ausdehnung und umfasst 104.659 km<sup>2</sup>. Kentucky can be divided into five primary regions: the Cumberland Plateau in the east, the north-central Bluegrass region, the south-central and western Pennyroyal Plateau (also known as the Pennyrile or Mississippi Plateau), the Western Coal Fields and the far-west Jackson Purchase. Henderson is a home rule-class city along the Ohio River in Henderson County in western Kentucky in the United States. The population was 28,757 at the 2010 U.S. census. It is part of the Evansville Metropolitan Area, locally known as the "Kentuckiana" or the "Tri-State Area". From its headwaters in Lechter County, Kentucky, to its mouth at Smithland on the Ohio River, the Cumberland River travels almost 700 miles and drains a watershed of 18,000 square miles.
