The Modern Middle East: A History, Fourth Edition, is engagingly written--drawing from the author's own research and other studies--and enriched with maps and photographs, original documents, and an abundance of supplementary materials. Read this book in preparation for the Into to the Modern Middle East DSST test. It's well written and interesting, giving a broad picture of events without getting bogged down in the details. While I may not agree with all of the positions, it was an interesting read. "The Modern Middle East is by far the best textbook for introductory and survey courses. In a humorous and conversational style, it offers a substantial analytical and interpretive framework, not just a litany of dry facts that most students will likely forget after their exams.
