Early Christianity arose as a movement within Second Temple Judaism, following the teachings of Jesus of Nazareth. With a missionary commitment to both Jews and Gentiles (non-Jews), Christianity rapidly spread into the greater Roman empire and beyond. Here, Christianity came into contact with the dominant Pagan religions. Now remembered primarily as Franz Kafka's friend and literary executor, Max Brod was an accomplished thinker and writer in his own right. In this volume, he considers the nature and differences between Judaism and Christianity, addressing some of the most perplexing questions at the heart of human existence. Judaism's paganism is revealed in the Jews' widely-accepted Chumash, extensive commentary in defense of Jewish beliefs, including belief in reincarnation, gilgul neshamot.
