Richard III, also called (1461–83) Richard Plantagenet, duke of Gloucester, (born October 2, 1452, Fotheringhay Castle, Northamptonshire, England—died August 22, 1485, near Market Bosworth, Leicestershire), the last Plantagenet and Yorkist king of England. King Richard III has been portrayed as a tyrant and killer, largely due to the play by William Shakespeare. However, the bard took considerable artistic license and the facts are not quite as bloody.
