Francisco de Quevedo (1580–1645), one of the greatest poets of the Spanish Golden Age, was the master of the baroque style known as “conceptismo,” a complex form of expression fueled by elaborate conceits and constant wordplay as well as ethical and philosophical concerns. note that Quevedo (1580–1645), who wrote various commentaries and dedicatory epistles, was keenly aware of how fickle literary tastes could be. Like Borges, Quevedo believed that only the poet who confronted his own belatedness and debts to the past could hope to survive the vagaries of taste. 1.
