James is a physician and author, both of the international bestseller “Six Months in Sudan” and more recently, “Life on the Ground Floor“. He practices emergency medicine and trauma at St. Michael’s, Toronto’s inner-city hospital and is an award winning teacher at the University of Toronto. Maskalyk’s book is an account of six months working as a doctor for Médecins Sans Frontières, from the bureaucratic limbo-like state before the actual mission and including the time immediately after his return home and his, presumably temporary, feelings of dissociation from society. James Maskalyk set out for the contested border town of Abyei, Sudan, in 2007.
