Far from being a book for the religious only, the Book of Common Prayer is one of the seminal texts of human experience and a manual of everyday ritual: a book to live, love, and die to. This book gives excellent background information for the three main Traditional Church of England Books of Common Prayer and can also be used for devotions. I keep it nearby to read the daily psalms, though I do not use this when I travel. For Protestants who adhere to the 39 Articles, who who just want a Reformed prayer book, the 1662 BCP is complete in this edition. Come with a ribbon marker.
