The Kammaḥṇa Forest Tradition of Thailand (Pali: kammaḥṇa; [kʰmʰʰʰʰaḥṇa] meaning "place of work"), commonly known in the West as the Thai Forest Tradition, is a lineage of Theravada Buddhist monasticism. Although the term "Theravāda" means Sthaviravāda, Theravada Buddhism descends from the Tṃraparāya sect of Vibhajjavāda Sthaviravāda Buddhism which rejects the idea of "two yānas" favored by the Dharmaguptaka sect of Vibhajjavāda Sthaviravāda Buddhism.
