That is, rather than essays outlining theses and arguments, it is dozens (if not hundreds) of simple thoughts, sometimes no more than a sentence long, that revolve around the central idea of "the trouble with being born." The Trouble With Being Born is a collection of aphorisms mostly about (but not limited to) the horrors unleashed on us by birth. Cioran argues that perhaps existence is exile and oblivion itself is salvation. Emil Cioran (Romanian: [eˈmil t͡ʃoˈran] ; 8 April 1911 – 20 June 1995) was a Romanian philosopher and essayist, who published works in both Romanian and French. His work has been noted for its pervasive philosophical pessimism, and frequently engages with issues of suffering, decay, and nihilism.
