

# Download The Unknown Lenin From The Secret Archive

THE WRITTEN LEGACY OF LENIN, the leader of the Bolshevik Party and head of the Soviet state, enjoyed the status of Holy Scripture in the Soviet Union: his every opinion was cited to justify one policy or another and treated as gospel. To learn about the real Lenin, read *10 Days That Shook the World* by John Reid, Trotsky's biography of him, or Tony Cliff's book on Lenin. All are much better and more accurate than this slew of out of context and deliberately misunderstood ( and perhaps inaccurate ) quotes from the "Unknown" Lenin. Lenin, born in 1870, was committed to revolutionary struggle from an early age - his elder brother was hanged for the attempted assassination of Czar Alexande Led the Soviets to power in October, 1917. The Unknown Lenin, containing long concealed documents from the Soviet archives, helps correct the myth and revise the image. Lenin emerges here as a ruthless, manipulative leader who used terror, subversion, and persecution to achieve his goals.
