

Download Windows 8 Netbook Resolution Regedit

If you want to increase the amount of screen real estate you have on your netbook or be able to use apps that require higher-resolution displays, like the Metro-style apps in Windows 8, you might be able to make a registry change to get options for higher resolutions. With Windows XP my netbook started up in approx 3 minutes; now on Windows 8 within the minute. One click on the desktop icon, one click on Outlook 2010 and 30 secs later I have my email from 10 accounts loaded. The good news is that if you've downloaded the Windows 8 Developer Preview to test on your netbook, there's a simple registry hack that may allow you to adjust the screen resolution and run ...Hi, I would like to know is there any way to set the monitor screen resolution through command line or registry in Windows 7 by default apart from using 3rd party tools?
